## **Dr. Amir Jamali's bio:**

Dr. Amir Jamali is currently medical director at Joint Preservation Institute. He graduated from University of Virginia and attended medical school at the Medical College of Virginia. He completed residency training at UC San Diego including a one year fellowship in orthopaedic research and muscle physiology. He then performed a fellowship in Adult Reconstructive Orthopaedic Surgery at Massachusetts General Hospital and worked with one of the worldwide pioneers in hip replacement surgery, Dr. William Harris. Dr. Jamali also completed a fellowship in Hip Preservation Surgery at the University of Berne under Prof. Reinhold Ganz, one of the most innovative orthopaedic surgeons of the last 50 years.

Dr Jamali was faculty at UC Davis for 7 years and started the Joint Preservation Institute in early 2010. The goal of the institute is to provide customized treatments for patients of all ages based on the specific location and extent of their injuries and arthritis.

Dr Jamali has published over 45 peer reviewed publications and over 100 abstracts and book chapters. He continues to be actively involved in the orthopaedic department at UC Davis and collaborate with a number of



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
